The minister emphasized that the collaboration with RSPO aims to mitigate the negative impacts of the palm oil industry on tropical rainforests, biodiversity, and the rights of local residents. Cooperative efforts will promote transparency, accountability, and active participation to transition towards more sustainable palm oil production and enhance the economic value for palm farmers.

# Balancing Economic Development and Environmental Conservation in Oil Palm

India is pursuing a responsible path, aiming to strike a balance between palm oil economic needs and environmental conservation. India's palm oil push has the potential to yield tremendous benefits for the country's economy, its farmers, and its bid for self-sufficiency. When carried out responsibly, oil palm cultivation can also contribute to further India's carbon neutrality goals as plantations act as carbon sinks sequestering carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. At the same time, careful landuse planning can reduce the pressure on high biodiversity landscapes.

## Mega Oil Palm Plantation drive organized in 49 districts of 11 states of India

Various State Governments along with Oil Palm Processing Companies, organized a Mega Oil Palm Plantation Drive from 25th of July 2023 till 12th August 2023. Through this drive, the states and the companies were able to reach out to more than 7000 farmers in 77 villages of 49 districts in 11 states, covering approximately 3500 ha. of the area and planting more than 5.00 lakh planting material.

Agriculture Minister Singireddy Niranjan Reddy stated that the State government is taking proactive measures to promote oil palm cultivation, keeping in view the future requirements of the State. He added that the government is providing subsidies to farmers to support oil palm cultivation. The subsidies cover expenses related to plant material, intercrop inputs, and drip irrigation. Currently, two processing mills and 38 oil palm nurseries are active in the state to support oil palm cultivation.
